

Hurricane Harvey

August 17 - September 1, 2017 • 60.58 inches

Harvey was the most significant tropical cyclone rainfall event in United States history, both in scope and peak rainfall amounts, since reliable rainfall records began in the 1880s. The highest official storm total rainfall report from Harvey was 60.58 inches near Nederland, Texas, with another report of 60.54 inches from near Groves, Texas. This image is from the afternoon of the August 25 and marked the beginning of the rain event.

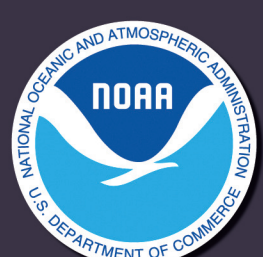
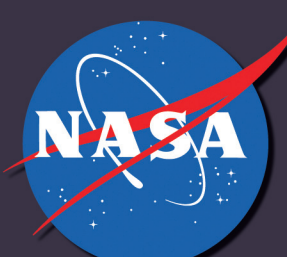
